* *The Continuum of interventions begins with outreach and testing and concludes with HIV viral load suppression and is generally referred to as the Continuum of HIV Care or Care Treatment Cascade. The Continuum of HIV Care includes the diagnosis of HIV, linkage to HIV medical care, lifelong retention in HIV medical care, appropriate prescription of ART, and ultimately HIV viral load suppression.*
