#### Motion Carried unanimously.

<u>Motion #4</u>: it was moved and seconded (Escamilla, Galley) to have the Office of Support include a statement in the EIIHA section of the HRSA application recognizing that currently available epidemiologic data consistently fail to assess the need for testing, referral, and linkage in vulnerable populations such as among those who are transgender, intersex, homeless, and those released from incarceration. Moving forward, the Houston Ryan White Planning Council will look to other sources, in addition to that provided by the Texas Department of Health Services, to document the needs of these vulnerable populations. Motion Carried unanimously.

**Houston EMA/HSDA Epidemiological Profile:** Williams said we received data, thanks to Sha'Terra Johnson's help in getting us what we needed. We have all of 2022 data but not all of 2023 so the 2022 data will be used for the 2024 Houston Area Epidemiological Supplement. Escamilla asked that we include information from the HIV.gov AHEAD dashboard as well.

**Houston EMA/HSDA HIV Needs Assessment:** Williams said that 560 surveys were completed and Beth is currently preparing data that the Priority and Allocations Committee needs to set service priorities on Monday.

**EHE/Integrated HIV Prevention & Care Planning Body:** Williams said that the Office of Support will start referring to this as the Joint Plan. See attached Summary of May 2024 activities for all committees and workgroups. Each of the Committees and Workgroups is moving along with their work including a citywide youth group. Also attached is a PowerPoint from the Houston Health Department on their EHE program.

#### Aging and HIV Workgroup, Diane Beck, RWOS

The July meeting was cancelled, but important updates include the following from Ryan White Grant Administration: the Ryan White Part A-funded Aging and HIV Project began in July 2024 through the local AIDS Education and Training Center (AETC) provider, Baylor College of Medicine. The project provides technical assistance and training to providers to address the health care and psychosocial needs of people aging with HIV. Specifically, the Ryan White Planning Council has created five case manager positions. Those hired will be trained by AETC to be geriatric HIV case managers. These case managers will encourage physicians to collect baseline data on older adults living with HIV, with the intent of using the data to develop appropriate services. Ryan White Part A is already prepared to underwrite the cost of the tests through the primary care funded service category. At the September workgroup meeting, members will watch a panel discussion from On Aging 2024, entitled "The Duality of Aging with HIV: Understanding the Structural and Policy Barriers for Older People Living with HIV (PLWH)," moderated by Carmen Villar, vice president of public affairs at Gilead Sciences. Also, featuring Bamby Salcedo, CEO of TransLatin@ Coalition; Jeff Berry, executive director, The Reunion Project; and Malcolm Reid, director of policy, THRIVE SS. Next meeting: Noon, Wednesday, September 18, 2024
